

# Building Committee Survey - 2009

1. What do you like best about the current space at Prince of Peace that you use for your ministry?  
 -likes intimacy of the sanct. space. Likes her current office very much!! We couldn't increase staff w/o more office space. Likes humility of the sanctuary, flexible seating, open windows to outside. Likes BYC but far away, no kitchen for food.
  2. What is it that makes us feel we need some more space?  
 More staff space for +1 person. No food prep in BYC. Would like a better youth room. More H/C <sup>access</sup> bathrooms → <sup>cherry table in restroom</sup> (sign) for nursery, good flexibility, tho'.
  3. In what way is your ministry limited by our current space?  
 Youth space. Would be nice to have a dedicated Youth Room that youth could "take over." Bigger "gathering space". FH is too small. ③ Sunday Am Sunday School location + class space. We have to use each Pt's ofc.
  4. What would make Prince of Peace a more welcoming space?  
 Small hallway for coffee + flow is awkward. This is really inconvenient and make us feel cramped.
  5. How can we improve our church's visibility?  
 Enlarge narthex - esp hallway to "complete the square" (glassed in). Also, where is the entrance? Clearly marked entrance. • Web ministry • Better signage: + bigger worship times: but there is church signs as allowed in state.
  6. In what ways could our future ministries be improved by adding or changing our current space?  
 \* Bigger kitchen, + \*fellowship space → then sanctuary  
 Idea: Temporary partitions to block <sup>view of</sup> entrance doors when narthex is in use.
  7. Where do you feel our/your ministry will be in 5 years?  
 YM seems to drive the congregation. People seem to come and are energized by youth. focus on SS, HS + MS youth. Nice to have the nursery.
  8. What would make our space more comfortable?  
 More storage. Some permanent meeting space with "elbow room" + A/V amenities (widescreen TV on wall, etc.)
  9. Do you have any ideas for better utilizing the space we have outside our buildings?  
 Put a pavilion in the forest. Back of parking lot - do something. Mark smaller parking spaces. Make front yard more welcoming + visible. More parking in front. Do the second garden.
