1. What do you like best about the current space at Prince of Peace that you use for your ministry?
We have storage sheds for tools + other church items
2. What is it that makes us feel we need some more space?
We need to have a place to put the 12ft stepladder (The shed does not work for this). We need O/H storage in the shed for long items like lumber
3. In what way is your ministry limited by our current space?
See above. The furnace room gets used for storage. It needs to be kept clear as possible. See also #6 (Fellowship Hall). We need a larger and more intimate narthex.
4. What would make Prince of Peace a more welcoming space?
Explore better landscaping for the front yard. Reducing the berm height would make the church more visible. We
5. How can we improve our church's visibility?
We need a more permanent sign in front to identify ourselves. Something that conveys the message, "This is a church."
6. In what ways could our future ministries be improved by adding or changing our current space?
See #2 (Shed O/H storage). We need a larger Fellowship Hall space. Our current space is inadequate.
7. Where do you feel our/your ministry will be in 5 years? We could expand the narthex into the courtyard bet^w FH + current narthex.
8. What would make our space more comfortable? (See #6, #7~~2~~, #3-intimate narthex)
Drapes + window treatment in the Fellowship Hall. Hardwood overlay on the floor.
9. Do you have any ideas for better utilizing the space we have outside our buildings?
A sealable shed or garage that can be used to store more delicate items such as sanctuary chairs.
10. Would any of your suggestions change if we evaluated them from an environmental perspective?
Construct a "lean to" adjacent to the far shed to be used for sign storage. (Take the sign rack out of the current shed interior)
