1. What do you like best about the current space at Prince of Peace that you use for your ministry?

Full accessibility, one level; sanctuary space is welcoming

2. What is it that makes us feel we need some more space?

- Crowded when we have churchwide social function.

- Need bigger fellowship gathering space.

- Narthex also crowded. Need expanded kitchen - commercial.

3. In what way is your ministry limited by our current space?

Movable partitions in fellowship space create some problems

4. What would make Prince of Peace a more welcoming space?

- Install wall sign on both entrances with church name +

- Move parking on Rt 28 side of church building

5. How can we improve our church's visibility?

Construct permanent, larger sign on Route 28. Possibly with electronic message boards. Existing sign looks temporary + lettering too small for Rt 28 traffic doing 40+ mph.

6. In what ways could our future ministries be improved by adding or changing our current space?

Increased revenue from more rental of space which could be used for operating expenses + outreach
